

REACH Compliance Statement – August 2008

Airedale International Air Conditioning Limited is fully aware of the requirements of REACH, the new EU Regulation on the Registration, Evaluation and Authorisation of Chemicals, and the dates by which various activities must be implemented.

Airedale is classed as a downstream user, therefore we are not required to pre-register or register any products we supply. We are currently in the process of collating relevant information both internally and with suppliers to ensure that together we fully implement the requirements of REACH.

Most of the activities required for the pre-registration phase are carried out by manufacturers and importers. However, we are in close contact with our suppliers to make sure they are pre-registering all products, to ensure continuity of supply to our customers.

We will achieve this by working with our supply chain to:

- ✓ Identify all substances and preparations which require pre-registration / registration
- ✓ Where there is a potential risk that a product supplied may not be pre-registered, alternatives will be sought and evaluated
- ✓ Substances or preparations which have a 'very high concern' will be designed out and safer alternatives sought

At this time, we are not aware of any products supplied to us that will be withdrawn due to the requirements of REACH.
